Accreditation

Grace Brethren Schools, a non-profit educational institution, was established in 1978 as a ministry of Grace Brethren Church. Grace Brethren Schools is a duly accredited institution and a member of the Associated Christian Schools International (ACSI) and Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).

Admissions

Grace Brethren Jr/Sr High has approximately 420 students in grades 7-12. **Senior Class Size: 69** In order to be considered for acceptance into Grace Brethren Schools, a student needs to:

- 1. Be receptive to instruction in and through a Christian worldview as well as desirous of learning more about a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
- 2. Be submissive to the policies and procedures set forth by Grace Brethren Church and Schools.
- 3. Have parents/guardians who support the philosophy and educational process of Grace Brethren Schools, its administration, teachers and staff.

Graduation Requirements

- A total of 270 units with a minimum GPA of 2.0 are required for Grace Brethren High School graduation.
- Grace Brethren Jr/Sr High School assigns 5 units of credit per course each semester.
- 12th Grade students must successfully complete the following credits to receive a diploma from GBS: Bible (40), English (40), Mathematics (minimum of 30), Social Sciences (35), Science (30), Foreign Language (20), P.E (10), Visual Performing Art (10), Expository Composition (5) and Critical Thinking & Composition (5), Elective Units (45).

Ranking

Grace Brethren Jr/Sr High does NOT rank students.

AP Classes: 15 AP classes are offered in 9th- 12th grades. Approximately 75% of eligible 11th and 12th grade students take at least one AP class and the corresponding AP exam.
